


# Specimen Labeling



#### **Properly Labeled Tubes**

- · Accession and name oriented closest to the cap
- Label covers the manufacturer label
- Window view to specimen
- Nominal fill range or fill line is visible
- Barcode label **does not** cover the culture bottle barcode



#### Unacceptable

Accession and name oriented towards bottom

# Centrifuge Gel Tubes

#### **Immediately** after draw





### After clotting

Minimum 1/2 hour to maximum 2 hours after draw



15 MINUTES, swing bucket centrifuge 20 MINUTES, fixed angle centrifuge


### Order of Draw

Order of Draw	Mix by Inverting	Centrifuge	Refrigerate
ROYAL BLUE	<b>8-10</b> times	No	Yes
LIGHT BLUE	4 times	No	No
RED RED	<b>5-10</b> times	Yes (after clots)	Yes
GREEN	<b>8-10</b> times	Yes	Yes
TALL GREEN	<b>8-10</b> times	Yes	Yes
LAVENDER	<b>8-10</b> times	No	Yes
POST ORDER OF DRAW			
GOLD/WHITE	<b>8-10</b> times	Yes	Yes



Draw all specimens, except POST BUN (Gold/White), prior to administering heparin

# Specimen Packaging




### **Room Temperature**

Must use Specimen Transport Biohazard bag with absorbent sheet.







### Refrigerated

Freeze ice packs flat.

Must use Specimen Transport Biohazard bag with absorbent sheet. Use foam layer.

Specimens must not touch ice packs.
